Good luck, and work hard to best represent yourself throughout this process.

Your candidacy will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Past performance
2. Quality of your application
3. Future leadership potential
4. Best fit for the individual and organization

When completing the application, be thorough, complete, creative, and honest. Don't say what you think we want to hear. Say what you really believe. Leaders are people who can offer something new and different to the organization. This application process is structured to allow you to gain personal insight as well as to allow us to get to you know you better. Be open and show the person you truly are, or that you aspire to be. Whether you are chosen to participate in the position you apply for is not the ultimate goal of this process. The goal should be self-improvement, self-reflection, and learning about leadership. **Please do not fill out this application unless you are prepared to accept all outcomes of this audition process.** Drum major applicants should plan on attending the George Parks Drum Major Academy if accepted as a WHS Drum Major. 1. Please provide a resume. Be sure to highlight your past leadership roles and experiences.
2. On a separate sheet of paper please answer the following questions:
  - What are your greatest personal strengths?
  - What aspect of leadership is most frightening/intimidating to you?
  - What are some areas that the organization could improve and how would you improve them?
3. Interview someone on the WHS Campus (student, faculty, or administrator) and ask him or her for his or her views on leadership. What did you learn from your conversation? How did their view of leadership differ from yours?
4. Share the this [teacher recommendation link](#) with two teachers and ask them to fill it out on your behalf. It is your responsibility to ensure that your teachers fill out the recommendation form by the May 16<sup>th</sup> deadline. **Recommendations will not be accepted after May 16<sup>th</sup>.**

- A leader will not have unexcused absences to rehearsals or performances for any reason.
- A leader will uphold the highest possible standards as set for all band members.
- A leader will participate in all band-related events (parades, community events, pep rallies, etc).
- If not chosen, I will assume my regular role in the band with integrity and will give full support and cooperation to the other members selected by the Directors.

**Please understand that if chosen, you will be held to a higher standard of behavior, performance, and work ethic than your peers.
